Specificity:

This clone has been derived from hybridisation of SP2/0 cells with spleen cells of a BALB/c mouse immunised with human erythrocytes. This antibody has been clustered to in the seventh international Workshop on Human White Cell differentiation Antigens. The monoclonal antibody is directed against the alpha-chain of glycophorin. In direct agglutination tests this monoclonal antibody reacts with normoblasts and erythrocytes. No reaction occurs with En(a-) erythrocytes and other normal peripheral blood cells.

Isotype subclass: Mouse IgG1

Purification: Ammonium sulphate precipitation and ion exchange chromatography, followed by affinity

chromatography.

Physical state: Liquid

Buffer/Additives/Preservative: PBS containing 0.09 % sodium azide (pH 7.2).

Expiration date: The reagent is stable until the expiry date stated on the vial label.

Storage conditions: Store at 4 °C. For long-term storage aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.

Application: The monoclonal antibody is very useful for the recognition of malignant erythroblastic diseases.

Warning: Sodium azide is harmful if swallowed (R22). Keep out of reach of children (S2). Keep away from food, drink and animal feeding stuff (S13). Wear suitable protective clothing (S36).
